- Annual Pet Registration: All cats and dogs residing within the limits must be registered annually with the City of West Branch. Registrations and tags for 2014 are now available at City Offices located at 110 North Poplar Street. Residents are asked to provide current rabies vaccination papers at the time of registration. The fee for registering pets is \$5.00 per animal. A \$5.00 late penalty fee may be applied if an animal is registered after January 31st, 2014.
- **Planning & Zoning Commission:** A Planning & Zoning Commission Meeting will be held on Tuesday January 28<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 p.m. in the City Council Chambers. Agenda items include a site plan for a 197' Cellular Tower and an introduction to the plans for Meadows Subdivision, Part II.
- Library Building Project Site Selection Update: Dan Stevenson, President of the West Branch Public Library Board of Trustees will be on hand at the February 3<sup>rd</sup> Council Meeting to brief Council Members on the latest efforts of the Library Board of Trustees on the Library Building Project. The Board has discussed implications of the West Branch Community School Districts 15-Year Master Facilities Plan and how this might affect the site selection process.

- Park Planning Steering Committee Meeting: Both the Park & Recreation Commission and the Park & Recreation Steering Committee met on Thursday January 23<sup>rd</sup> to discuss the public input survey that will be presented to members of the West Branch Community in the coming weeks. The purpose of the survey will be to include the community's wishes in the Strategic Park Plan. Steering members suggested that the surveys be distributed through the West Branch Times, the West Branch Elementary School Friday Folder and at area businesses. An online survey will also be made available.
- **Electronic Packets:** With the guidance of Councilperson Pierce, Library Director Nick Shimmin took the next steps toward providing paperless Council Packets this week. A set of Samsung Galaxy Note tablets were purchased from Best Buy for all Council Members and the Mayor. The Note was chosen based on the input from council, methodologies for providing electronic packets, and the capabilities of the current tablets on the market. There is no timeline currently available for the implementation of the tablets and paperless packets, though the city staff will work to provide them as quickly as possible.
- Indoor Walking and Tumbling: Park and recreation participation continues to thrive in spite of the cold weather. Wednesday indoor walking averages ten participants each week and Wednesday roundup averages fifteen participants, with both continuing until mid-March. Tumbling also started this week with six children registered in the preschool class and eight children in the after school class. This is a twelve-week program led by Iowa Gym-Nest.
