- **August 15th Deadline to Apply for Individual Disaster Assistance:** Community Action of Eastern Iowa and Cedar County Public Health have contacted the City of West Branch concerning individual disaster assistance that is available to residents whose household income is 200% or less of the Federal Property Level. Applications must be received by Community Action of Eastern Iowa no later than August 15th. Applications can only be made for disaster related expenses or damages which are not covered by insurance.
