<u>Alliant Energy Project Update:</u> In an effort to inform customers of work that they will be completing in the area, Alliant will be sending letters to residents who live near E. Orange Street and N. 6th and N. 4th Streets. Below is an excerpt from those letters:

"Interstate Power & Light, an Alliant Energy company, has a construction project in your area. This is a continuing effort to upgrade our facilities to ensure the safety and reliability of our electric system.

Our contractor, Michel's Construction, will be replacing and upgrading our facilities in West Branch along E. Orange, E. Lemon & N. 6th St. The work will begin approximately the week of 3/30/2015 and will be completed approximately on 5/01/2015. We do not anticipate any interruption to your electrical service at this time. If needed, we will notify you of any planned interruptions with a separate notification.
