<u>Main Street Sidewalk Project – Phase 2:</u> The Main Street Sidewalk Project will be under construction starting Monday April 27th. Parking and traffic restrictions will be in place during the duration of the project. Please <u>click here</u> to view the project map. The project area includes:

- East side of the Hoover House
- S. Downey St. (between Wetherell and Main Street)
- South side of Main St. (between S. Downey St. to the east of Reid's Beans)

During this construction phase, streets will be closed and alternate traffic paths will be created.

STREET CLOSURES:

<u>Wetherell St.</u> – (between S. Poplar St. and S. Downey St.) Only Post Office and cement trucks will be allowed in this area during construction.)

S. Downey St. – (between Wetherell St. and Main Street)

DETOURS:

<u>S. Poplar St.</u> - During this construction phase, S. Poplar St. will be changed to one way going <u>north</u>. Signs will be posted. <u>No parking</u> will be allowed on S. Poplar during construction.

<u>Enlow Parking Lot</u> – parking lot east of The West Branch Times – will be used for the residents of Wetherell St. and W. Main Street to access their homes. These residents will use S. Poplar St. to access Main St.

PARKING:

Overnight parking will be allowed for affected residents on Main St. between Poplar and Downey. The Enlow Parking lot can also be used.
