- Prescription Drug Disposal Event Sat. Oct. 22<sup>nd</sup>, 10:00 a.m.-Noon: The West Branch Police Department, in cooperation with the Drug Enforcement Administration, will be hosting a drug disposal event on Saturday, October 22, 2016 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at City Offices, located at 110 N Poplar Street. Expired or unused prescription drugs can be dropped off to a member of the Department for safe disposal. The event is a free service offered to the public. - Leaf Pickup is Now Underway: Public Works began its curbside leaf collection on Monday October 17th. Leaf collection begins at approximately 7:30 am on the east side of town every Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Public Works makes every attempt to reach the whole town each day, but occasionally leaf collection cannot be completed in one day. During those times, Public Works will do another collection the following day for residents that could not be picked up the previous day. The City asks that leaves be raked to the curb for pickup and be free of tree limbs, sticks, grass clippings and garbage. Leaves mixed with other yard waste or placed in plastic bags will not be accepted.

Also as a reminder, the City's curbside yard waste collection is on the first and third Thursday of every month during the spring, summer and fall months. Yard waste includes grass clippings, leaves, wastes common in gardening or landscaping, clippings from bushes or shrubs, sticks and tree limbs. All limbs too large for a container must be cut to under 4 foot lengths and be in manageable bundles at the curbside. All other yard waste must be bagged or placed in a container at the curbside. All containers must be under 50 pounds and any bag used must be a decomposable bag. Any yard waste in plastic bags will not be accepted.

The City's Public Works department will continue both collections until December 2nd. After that time, residents can haul yard waste to the City Brush Pile located a half mile east of S. Downey Street on Fawcett Drive. The City does not accept yard waste in plastic bags, any kind of construction material, garbage, dirt or rock in this area. - Halloween Soup Supper & Costume Contest: Trick or Treat is from 5:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. and the Halloween Soup Supper will take place between 5:00-7:30 p.m. on Halloween, Monday October 31st at the West Branch Fire Station. The event flyer is attached to this week's *Update*. The Halloween Soup Supper and Costume Contest is hosted by the City of West Branch Parks & Recreation Department in cooperation with the Animal Control Commission and the West Branch Police and Fire Departments. Food will be served from 5:00-7:30 p.m. at the Fire Station located at 105 South Second Street. One change to the event this year is the timing of the costume contest. This year, the costume contest starts promptly at 6:00 p.m. Prizes will be awarded for best costume in various age categories, as well as Best Family Costume, Best Pet Costume, Best Pet and Owner Costume, and Scariest Overall Costume.
- Wapsi Creek Park: While there is still some finish grading and other work that needs to be completed with the project, families are already starting to enjoy the new playground equipment that was installed at Wapsi Creek Park. City staff has already received many positive comments from residents who have walked by or played in the park.
- 4<sup>th</sup> Street Almost Finished: The paving of 4<sup>th</sup> Street has been completed. Starting on October 20<sup>th</sup>, the paving of driveways and sidewalks is scheduled to begin. Access to the West Branch Animal Clinic and all properties on N. 4<sup>th</sup> Street north of the clinic will continue to be from the north until the approaches are completed. The parking lot for the West Branch Animal Clinic is scheduled to be paved on Friday October 28<sup>th</sup>. Residents who are located close to the clinic are asked to continue using street parking on 4<sup>th</sup> Street south of the project.
