

RESOLUTION NO. 1116

RESOLUTION PROVIDING NOTICE TO THE JOHNSON COUNTY E911 BOARD OF THE CITY'S INTENT TO CANCEL THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN JOHNSON COUNTY E911 BOARD AND THE CITY OF WEST BRANCH, IOWA FOR THE PROVISION OF CODE RED SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City previously entered into a Code Red Services Agreement with the Johnson County E911 Board dated December 8, 2009 (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the contract that the Johnson County E911 Board previously had in place with Code Red is due to expire; and

WHEREAS, the Johnson County E911 Board is currently pursuing a service contract with another service provider; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Code Red Services Agreement, the City will continue to pay a \$1000 annual fee until written notice is provided to the Johnson County E911 Board; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to provide written notice of cancellation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of West Branch, Cedar County, Iowa, that the aforementioned Agreement be and the same is hereby cancelled. Further, the City Administrator is directed to send a letter notifying the Johnson County E911 Board of the same.
