## **Siren Protocol**

#### Regular Time Siren

Siren is a short up and down very quick sound. This is an automatic siren.

### Fire Department Response Siren

(all medical and fire calls)
Siren is an up and down multiple times sound.
This has to be alarmed by someone at the fire station.

# <u>Tornado Warning or Severe Storm Warning Siren</u>

Siren is a <u>very</u> long whirling sound.

Tornado/Storm Warning Sirens will only be used if we are registering more than 70 mile an hour winds, and or under a Tornado Warning in the West Branch City Limits.

This has to be alarmed by someone at the fire station.

## Outdoor Warning Siren Testing

Siren is a <u>very</u> long whirling sound.

Testing will occur on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of each month,

April through October at 6:30 p.m.,

unless there is an immediate severe weather threat.

\*Reminder these are outside sirens you may not be able to hear them from inside your house!
